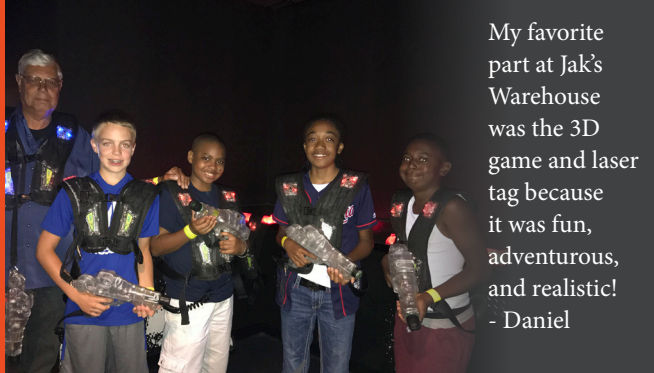

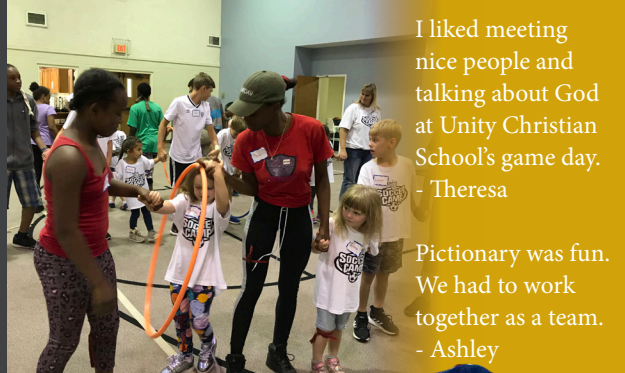

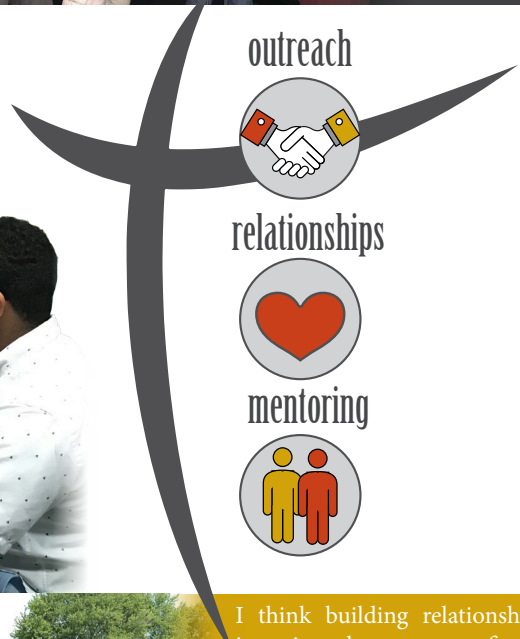
My favorite part at Jak's Warehouse was the 3D game and laser tag because it was fun, adventurous, and realistic! - Daniel
