

Throughout this process, Terrence constantly bugged me to let him work at the wood lot when the weather became nicer. In May, I finally gave in and frankly, he has surprised me with his work ethic. Terrence continues to work, is able to rent his own room, attends church weekly, and helps hand out Wednesday's coffee.

Through our children's ministry, our ordinary activities give us opportunities to impact a child by modeling proper behavior. For example, after packing school supplies at Elim Christian Services,

we were enjoying lunch at Culver's and the boys began talking how cool it would be to "finesse," a.k.a. steal, a second ice cream. This interaction gave us the opportunity to confront the group and discuss the negative impacts of stealing.



SUMMER HIGHLIGHTS




